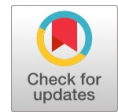


Understanding the Changes in Caste System in India

In order to promote sanskritization, the caste should have three conditions, i.e. having a touchable status, it should have a better economic condition and it should make a claim to membership into the high caste, by the propagation of some story or myth. It means that a particular low caste changes its position into the high caste in the particular area and there are not any changes in the caste structure. Through the process of sanskritization, there are few lower castes that have changed their position into the high castes. Therefore, sanskritization is regarded as one of the indispensable factors responsible for bringing about changes within caste system.

A. Westernization

Westernization is referred to the process by which individuals and groups adopt a western way of life. In this case, major adoption is put upon implementing factors, which would be facilitating in bringing about changes in the overall personality traits of individuals.
